EXPLANATORY NOTE

Oportun Financial Corporation (the "*Registrant*") is filing this Registration Statement on Form S-8 for the purpose of registering (a) an additional 1,667,730 shares of the Registrant's Common Stock issuable to eligible persons pursuant to the Registrant's 2019 Equity Incentive Plan, and (b) an additional 333,546 shares of the Registrant's Common Stock issuable to eligible persons pursuant to the Registrant's 2019 Employee Stock Purchase Plan. The shares being registered pursuant to this Registranton Statement are securities of the same class as and in addition to other securities for which the Registration Statement on Form S-8 on September 27, 2019 (File No. 333-233979), a Registration Statement on Form S-8 on March 5, 2020 (File No. 333-236893), a Registration Statement on Form S-8 on February 23, 2021, (File No. 333-253375), and a Registration Statement on Form S-8 on March 1, 2022 (File No. 333-263133) (collectively, the "*Prior Registration Statements*").
